ABOUT THE MEET

The Boston Trolley Meet has been a bi-annual tradition in Boston for many years, run by the Boston Chapter of the National Railway Historical Society. This year, the Meet is being presented by the *Boston Street Railway Association*, *Seashore Trolley Museum/NEERHS*, *Bay State Society of Model Engineers*, and the *Boston Chapter of the NRHS*, and has become the **2010 Boston Trolley & Transit Meet!**

This year's meet will feature hourly door prizes, continuous video entertainment, several model clinics, historic buses on display from Seashore Trolley Museum, an open house (with O-scale trolley and railroad layouts) at the Bay State Society of Model Engineers, and more!

The meet will also feature a model trolley and transit contest with prizes awarded in vehicle and structure categories. All model sizes are welcome. Contest details will be posted on www.bostontrolleymeet.com.

The Americal Civic Center (Armory) offers 7,100 square feet of exhibit space, and "roll in-roll out access" — far larger than past shows! The Boston Trolley & Transit Meet welcomes modelers and layouts of many kinds to show off their work to fellow enthusiasts and the interested public. We welcome modelers and layouts focused **primarily** on traction/trolleys and transit (including rapid transit and buses). Models of all gauges are encouraged.

Set-up times are Friday evening, 6-10 PM and Saturday morning, 8-9AM. All exhibitors **must** be set up prior to 9 AM Saturday. Exhibitors must also remain with their displays set-up through the 5 PM conclusion of the show.

The Boston Trolley & Transit Meet welcomes dealers of many types, including those specializing in models, memorabilia, books, multimedia, and paper. Because of the nature of the show, however, we ask that your offerings be **primarily** trolley/traction and/or transit-related.
